Dear Student:

The Southfield Kappa Foundation is now accepting applications for college scholarships from qualified **disadvantaged high school seniors** who live in **Oakland or Wayne** counties. The Southfield Kappa Foundation is a non-profit tax-exempt corporation founded by the members of the Southfield Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. to provide financial assistance to deserving minority students in the Detroit metropolitan area. The scholarships are typically one-year \$1,000 grants and are renewable. Scholarships are awarded based on academic achievement, community service activities and financial need.

Eligible applicants must plan to enroll full-time in a four-year degree program at an accredited college or university for either the fall 2013 or winter 2014 term. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative 2.75 GPA on a 4.0 scale and be active in community service activities.

Scholarship awards will be presented at the 24th Annual Touch of Klass Scholarship Affair Banquet hosted by the Southfield Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. The banquet will be held May 18, 2013 at a site TBD.

THE PROCEDURE IS AS FOLLOWS:

- Complete and return the attached application and include all required materials.
- The application must be complete and postmarked no later than **April 1, 2013**
- Selected finalists will be notified and interviews will follow by **April 16, 2013**
- Scholarship winners will be notified no later than **May 7** and will be expected to attend the Scholarship Banquet **on May, 18, 2013**.
